CATTLE

Important Note for Cattle Exhibitors

Procedure for Movement of (NI) Cattle into and out of Local Agricultural Shows

Disease Control - Only animals free from disease restrictions, including Tuberculosis, Brucellosis, Bluetongue and Bovine Viral Diarrhoea (herd or individual animal restrictions) may be permitted to move to a Show.

Bovine Tuberculosis Controls To minimise the risk to other livestock, exhibitors are encouraged to have "Show" animals tested for Tuberculosis by their Private Veterinary Practitioner in the 30 days beforehand. To minimise the risk to their own herd, exhibitors are encouraged to quarantine show animals and have them tested for Tuberculosis by their Private Veterinary Practitioner at least 42 days after their last appearance at a show and before reintegration to the main herd

Bovine Brucellosis Controls - Pre-movement testing for Bovine Brucellosis is no longer required for movement to shows

The Compulsory Bovine Viral Diarrhoea Scheme (BVD). Shows should put in place adequate biosecurity measures to reduce the risk of transmission on the premises. Best practice is that all cattle are from herds where every animal has been BVD tested with a negative result and there have been no BVD positive animals in the past 12 months. As a minimum, the following paragraphs must be met: For cattle born on/after 01/03/2016, only those animals with BVDN status on APHIS (negative BVD test result) can be moved into a "Show" herd. APHIS will block the movement of animals which don't have BVDN status, For cattle born before 01/03/2016, animals with an APHIS status of BVDP (positive), BVDI (inconclusive), DAMPI (dam of a positive animal) or OFFPI (offspring of a positive animal) cannot be moved into a "Show" herd. APHIS will block the movement of animals which have any of these statuses. For imported animals born on or after 1st March 2016 and resident in a NI herd, a BVDN status is required before the animal can be moved into a Show herd. Statuses can only be obtained where samples have been tested in laboratories approved under the NI scheme. AHWNI can attempt to obtain BVD statuses for animals that have been imported from the ROI, so owners of any such animals should contact AHWNI, allowing time for a test to be carried out should a BVD Negative result not be available. Imported animals, not resident in a NI herd and moving directly to a Show, should be tested with virus negative results or should be the dam of a virus-negative calf. Show Operators may ask for evidence of the relevant virus-negative test result or proof that the animal concerned is the dam of a virus-negative calf.

Proof of BVD Negative status Farmers can access the AHWNI database (www.animalhealthni.com). using their government gateway ID and password, for BVD test results and to print certificates of BVD negative test results. BVD statuses are also available on APHIS online and on APHIS herd lists. In summary, only those animals with a BVD status of BVDN (negative) INDNEG (indirect negative) or 'blank' (no BVD status on APHIS) can move into the Show Herd. Any animal with an APHIS status of BVDP, BVDI, DAMPI, OFFPI or BVDU (unknown) status cannot be moved into the "Show" herd. In respect of imported animals born on or after 1/3/2016, if a result from an approved laboratory has not already been provided by the vendor, the Bovine Viral Diarrhoea Scheme Order (Northern Ireland) 2016 requires a valid BVD test to be completed within 20 days of the date of importation. Show Secretaries are strongly advised to ask exhibitors to provide evidence of the BVD status of animals before entry, by providing a copy of the animal statuses taken from a recent NIFAIS herd-list, or an AHWNI certificate. (This will avoid a repeat of twoincidents in 2023 where non-negative animals attended Shows, which presented and avoidable disease risk to other exhibitor's cattle.) BVD Requirements for Shows wishing to include exhibitors from Ireland Ireland now has a European Commission approved BVD Eradication Programme. This increases the BVD requirements for the movement of cattle into Ireland. If a show in NI plans to include exhibitors from Ireland and plans to return these animals to their herds of origin via a non-co-minglement certificate, then the show will need to have additional BVD requirements for all exhibitors in place – including cattle from NI herds. Show organisers are advised to contact daeratradeexports@daera-ni.gov.uk well in advance of any planned show to discuss these additional arrangements. Show organisers must ensure that NI exhibitors are aware of any additional BVD requirements

Identification and movement

All cattle must be properly identified and comply with the Cattle Identification Regulations. General Principles • Cattle going to a Show must be included on an electronic movement document with the "Show" as the destination herd or be accompanied by a fully completed MC2 document with the "To" premises completed with the "Show" name and address and Animal Group Number. • Cattle moving from a Show must return to the herd they came from. • Cattle from the ROI may only attend Show premises in NI that are operating as EU Approved Assembly Centres for the relevant species on that day. The number of Shows to which cattle may travel is not limited provided these conditions are met on all occasions.

Cattle Movements to or from a Show for Keepers registered in Northern IrelandOn arrival at the Show, the cattle must be accompanied by a print-out of an electronic movement document created by the herd keeper on NIFAIS-on-Line (NOL) or a fully completed paper MC2 document.

Presenter's Responsibilities

1. Presenter completes either an electronic intention to move on NOL choosing the specific "Show" as the destination or a paper MC2 showing the destination as the "Show" premises. To facilitate checks at the Show the electronic movement document should be printed. 2. For those using paper documents the presenter brings the White, Yellow, and Pink copies of the MC2 to the Show. Presenter keeps the Blue copy. • All 3 copies will be checked by a Show Representative and stamped with the Show stamp.• The MC2C (pink) will be retained by the Show Operative.

3. For returning animals home from the Show, the Show Operative will produce a seller confirmed edocument returning the animal(s) to the presenting Herd.

4. Keepers registered to use NOL do not require any further documentation for the journey home but must confirm the move home on NOL within 7 days.

5. Keepers not registered to use NOL should receive a printed copy of the return Movement document from the Show Operative.

6. Keepers not registered to use NOL must confirm the move home by attaching one of their confirmation stickers and returning the movement document to their DAERA Direct office to arrive within 7 days of the move home or they can confirm the move home within 7 days using the Cattle Registration Line at 0300 200 7855.

Show Operator's Responsibilities.

1. Check that the cattle on the MC2/eDocument match those presented in terms of description and ear tag numbers.

2. On NOL confirm the animals (both those presented with a paper MC2 and those with an electronic Movement Document) into the Show Animal Group Number.

3. Apply the Show stamp to all the copies of the MC2 paper documents and: • Keep Pink (MC2B) copy of MC2 for Show's own records. • Return White and Yellow copy of incoming MC2s to local DDO by the next working day after the end of the Show.

4. At the end of the Show electronic "intentions to move" should be created for all cattle moving them back to their herds of origin. (N.B. animals should always be returned to the herds from which they moved to the show.

5. For keepers registered to use NOL no documentation needs to be supplied to the keeper.

6. For keepers not registered to use NOL 2 copies of the electronic movement document should be printed to enable the presenters to confirm the animals back into their herd and retain one for their own records.
